Pastor's Letter

Father Pat's Homily of February 5, 2017

*Jesus said to his
disciples: "You are the
salt of the earth.
But if salt loses its taste,
with what can it be
seasoned?
It is no longer good for
anything but to be
thrown out and
trampled underfoot.*

For many years, I had a fine doctor in Brooklyn. I often credit her with saving my life since she insisted on certain regular tests, that I often tried to avoid. One of those routine tests revealed an aortic aneurism that was potentially life-threatening. I had surgery and the concern was resolved. She and I had a running debate over the years about my blood pressure. It was always a bit high when she took it. I would tell her that it was fine at home when I took it at home. She told me I was eating too much salty foods, especially potato chips and pretzels. (I think she had a secret camera in the rectory!) I argued that it was because she scheduled too many appointments at the same time and that the stress of waiting endlessly in her office raised my pressure! I suppose neither the chips nor the waiting were helpful to me. It is probably not a popular idea on Super Bowl Sunday, the day that I consider the most glorious day for eating what some politically incorrect people call *junk food*. I prefer to call it *body building semi-nutritious borderline health food*.

Yet, there is no doubt that doctors and nutritionists have serious and valid concerns about too much salt. At the same time all of us need a sufficient amount of salt to stay healthy. I can recall some very anxious times when we had to take my elderly mother to the hospital because she had become dehydrated and quite disorientated. The doctors would give her IVs with

sodium and she would quickly bounce back to being herself. On very hot days, those exercising vigorously drink sports drinks that contain some salt or take salt pills.

In our Gospel today, Jesus tells us, *You are the salt of the earth. But if salt loses its taste, with what can it be seasoned? It is no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.* At the time of our Lord, salt was considered not only important as a seasoning, but also for the preservation of food since there was no refrigeration. Salt also has a symbolic meaning: eating salty food makes us thirsty for water. It is a compliment to say of someone that he or she is "*the salt of the earth.*"

What does it mean for you and me to be the salt of the earth? We live in a society that is growing increasingly secular. Although I believe all people by nature are spiritual, it seems to me that the desire for God and meaning is easily lost in daily living, with the hectic and demanding pace of modern life. Who has time for prayer and pondering the mystery of life? There always seems to be one more thing I must get done.

With some exceptions, the steady diet that our culture presents to us on television, in the movies, in music and on the internet at best avoids any serious religious concerns and at worst tends to ridicule and mock spiritual practices. Our world is in desperate need of the seasoning of Jesus Christ. Listen to the words we heard in our first reading from the prophet Isaiah: *Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own.* I am convinced that one on one compassion to our families, our friends, our neighbors, co-workers, and especially to those who are in need is *the saltiness* that Jesus calls us to.

Let me read to you part of a very salty letter that I receive the other day. It was addressed to the parishioners of St. Martin's. *Thank you so much for the joy and security that you brought to my family. We feel like we are part of your family. Without your outreach, my family and I would not have made it through a difficult time. I am so grateful for your care for my family and for the community.*

What did the parish do for this family is that touched her with the love of Jesus? You do it through your support of the parish, the dedication of all the staff, in particular the parish outreach team, the members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the many donations placed in the red wagon, the donations to the poor box. All those actions were bringing the salt of Jesus to others in need. At this Mass, as at all Masses, we will receive the Bread of Life and the Word of God here at the Eucharist, and we are called to touch a thirsty world with living waters. I am happy to be part of such a *salty* family.

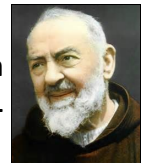
